For our Canadian athletes, this will be the opportunity of a lifetime: to compete at the Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games, at home, in Canada, with the support not only of immediate family and friends, but an entire nation.

In an effort to support the Canadian team and to help our athletes reach their goal of being the best in the world, Canadian Sport Centre Pacific (CSC Pacific) has created the **CSC Pacific Billet Program**. The CSC Pacific Billet Program is designed to reduce athlete and coach stress and enhance the Canadian team's performance at the 2010 Games by assisting their supporters with Games-time accommodations in Vancouver.

To accomplish this, CSC Pacific is seeking volunteers from Metro Vancouver who are willing to share their homes with relatives and close friends of Canadian athletes and coaches during the Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games.

Hosting the family and friends of Canada's top athletes and coaches will provide you the opportunity of a lifetime. Not only will you have the chance to experience the 2010 Games through the eyes of the Canadian team's biggest supporters, but you will also be positively impacting athlete performance.

As a Host in the Program, you will be expected to:

- Provide accommodation (private sleeping accommodation, bedding, towels, and a shared or private bath) and breakfast (for example, cereal/toast, juice and a hot beverage) for one to four Guests for 8 to 18 days during the Games hosting period (8 days is the standard commitment)
- Meet Guests upon their arrival at the Vancouver International Airport or at a mutually agreed upon location in Metro Vancouver (whichever is most convenient for the Guest) and transport them to the Host's home
- Arrange for Guest departures at the Vancouver International Airport or at a mutually agreed upon location in Metro Vancouver (whichever is most convenient for the Guest)
- Direct or assist Guests to the nearest public transit point each day
